

<p>Negative: SUBJECT + AM NOT / ARE NOT / IS NOT + (object, place, time)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">I + am not + Spanish.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">You, we, they + aren't + Argentinian.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">He, she, it + isn't + windy today.</p>		
<p>Interrogative:</p> <p>a. Yes / No questions: AM/ARE/IS + SUBJECT + (object / place / time) ?</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">ARE + you, we, they + at the mall? Yes, we are. / No, we aren't.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">IS + he, she, it tired? Yes, he is. / No, he isn't.</p> <p>b. W/H questions: W/H QUESTION WORD + AM/ARE/IS + SUBJECT + (object / place / time)?</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">Where + are + you, we, they + going on Saturday? We are going to the mall.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">When + is + he, she, it + leaving for Paris? He is leaving on Monday.</p>
