

And, but, because and so – Expanding Sentences

Take a short sentence. In turn, repeat it and add one of these conjunctions and a clause. Keep going, expanding the sentence, until one person forgets the order. For example:

I had a girlfriend.

I had a girlfriend, **and** I was happy.

I had a girlfriend, **and** I was happy, **but** she left me.

I had a girlfriend, **and** I was happy, **but** she left me, **so** I went out with someone else.

I had a girlfriend, **and** I was happy, **but** she left me, **so** I went out with someone else **because** I was lonely.

I had a girlfriend, **and** I was happy, **but** she left me, **so** I went out with someone else **because** I was lonely **and** then I was happier than before.
