

Speaking Exercise – Frozen

- a. **Look at the following text. Read it to yourself. When you feel happy that you know how to say the words, read it aloud:**

Frozen is a 2013 North American 3D computer-animated musical fantasy film produced by Walt Disney. It is the 53rd Disney animated feature film and was inspired by Hans Christian Andersen's 1844 fairy tale "The Snow Queen". It tells the story of a brave princess Anna who sets off on a journey with a strong iceman Kristoff, his loyal reindeer Sven, and a simple snowman Olaf to find her sister Elsa who was alone as her icy powers have trapped their kingdom in eternal winter.

Frozen premiered at the El Capitan Theatre in Hollywood. People loved it for its visuals, screenplay, themes, music, and voice acting; some film critics consider Frozen to be one of the best Disney animated feature films. The film earned Disney a lot of money with earnings of \$1.280 billion in worldwide box office revenues.

Frozen won two Academy Awards for Best Animated Feature and Best Original Song. Frozen 2 was released in 2019.
