

Improve your Writing - Parts of Speech!

How many parts of speech are there? Can you name them? Can you identify what each part of speech is used for?

Preposition – introduce phrases of time, place, how something is done.

Articles – used with nouns.

Interjections – express strong emotions or sensations.

Adjective – describe nouns.

Verbs – action / state of being.

Conjunction – join two parts of a sentence or phrase.

Adverb – describe verbs, adjectives and other adverbs.

Pronoun – replace nouns.

Nouns – people, places, things.

Look at this sentence. Identify each of the parts:

The young driver turned her new car quickly into a busy street. Bang! She hit a huge yellow bus and came to a stop.

Nouns – driver, car, street, bus.

Adjective – young, new, busy, huge, yellow.

Verb – turned, hit, came, stop.

Adverb – quickly.

Conjunction – and

Pronoun – he, she, her

Preposition – into, to

Interjection – Bang!

Articles – the, a
