

## Modals

Using words like 'have to', 'must', 'should', 'can', etc., create as many sentences as you can to say how you should behave in the following places. For example, "in a restaurant.":

You **should** not speak too loudly.

You **can** order whatever you want if you have enough money.

You **don't have to** wash the dishes after you've finished eating.

You **might** want to read a review of the place before you go.
