

Overview of Verb Tenses – Questions & Answers

What do you do every day?

I get up at 7, shower, get dressed, have breakfast, brush my teeth and leave the house.

What did you do yesterday?

I got up late, had class, met a friend, watched a film, organised my classes and then I went to bed.

What will you do tomorrow?

Not sure really. I will get up late, have breakfast, maybe meet a friend and possibly do some work in the afternoon.

What are you doing right now?

I am typing out the right answers to these silly questions!

What were you doing at this time yesterday?

I was watching TV.

What will you be doing at this time tomorrow?

I am going to be having fun with my friends. We will maybe go to a bar then possibly go out dancing.

What have you done since you got up this morning?

I have been in class all day since I got up this morning.

What had you done before you went to bed last night?

I had eaten dinner, watched TV, replied to some e-mails and then I went to bed.

What will you have done by the time you go to bed tonight? (Future Perfect)

I will have taught lots of classes and be really tired before I go to bed tonight.

What are you going to be doing next weekend?

I am going to be playing tennis at 1pm.

What are you doing? How long have you been doing it?

I am still typing! I have been typing for about 5 minutes.

What were you doing before we met today? How long had you been doing that? (Past Perfect Continuous)

I was running around all over the place before we met today. I had been running around since I got up at 7 this morning.

What will you be doing before we meet next? How long will you have been doing that? (Future Perfect Continuous)

I will be studying for my exam on Friday. I will have been studying every day as I need to pass this exam.
