

3rd Conditional - Story Telling

We are going to complete a story chain using the 3rd conditional. How does it work? Look at the sentence below:

“If I hadn’t moved to Chile, I wouldn’t have been to so many cool places.”

Now what you have to do is take the main clause and add an ‘if clause’ to move the story forward. For example:

“I wouldn’t have been to so many cool places if I hadn’t loved travelling from an early age.”

Now the rest of the class will take your sentence and come up with the next idea.

Now you try it with this sentence:

“If I hadn’t drunk so much beer, I wouldn’t have crashed my car.”

“I wouldn’t have crashed my car...”
