To suggest / recommend

These words are very similar in meaning but there is a subtle difference between them.

"<u>suggest</u>" = giving someone an idea in general. Making someone aware that it is a possibility:

I <u>suggest</u> that you wear a nice suit tomorrow. The boss is visiting the office. If you want to cook delicious dishes, I <u>suggest</u> that you buy fresh ingredients. My brother **suggested** pizza for dinner tonight. What do you think?

"recommend" = telling someone that a certain choice or option is the best one. I'm saying that I feel you should do it:

I <u>recommend</u> you try the chocolate cake. It's the best thing on the menu. Julio <u>recommended</u> Spain for our vacation. He said it was the best country he's ever been to.

The shop assistant <u>recommended</u> this book for people who are interested in Asian culture.

You can also say:

- Can I make a suggestion / recommendation?
- Why don't you...?
- Have you tried....?
- Maybe we could....?
- How about....?
- I have an idea....?
