Create the Question - Present Simple

Look at the following answers to questions. There is a combination of the verb 'to be' and other verbs in the present simple. Remember the following:

Verb to be:	Other verbs (play, talk, go, have, etc.)
 In questions, never use the verb 'to be' with an auxiliary (do, does). Never use the verb 'to be' with other verbs. 	 In questions, always use an auxiliary (do, does, can, etc.,) for verbs other than the verb 'to be'. When you use an auxiliary, never use the verb + 's'. It is always in the original form. Remember the auxiliary is always in the question but never in the answer apart from Yes / No questions.

Examples: I have cereal, yoghurt, and coffee. What do you have for breakfast?

- 20. I catch the bus to work.
- 21. Gonzalo's favourite colour is green.
- 22. My journey to work takes 30 minutes.
- 23. I never go to the theatre.
- 24. Sarah's favourite place in Santiago is Barrio Italia.
- 25. Felipe drinks 3 cups of coffee a day.
